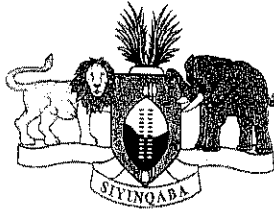

Re: COVID 19 VACCINATION FOR LEARNERS 12 to 17 YEARS

The Eswatini Government is continuing with the exercise of procuring, mobilizing and vaccinating all Emaswati according to age category in pursuit of the goal to have all citizens protected from COVID – 19.

The Ministry of Education and Ministry of Health will be conducting schools' campaign to vaccinate learners 12 to 17 years in all the schools (private and public). The learners have not been spared from the COVID-19 infections much as they are not severely affected by the disease yet. Cluster infections have been shown by the data from schools and it has been observed that adherence to compliance to COVID 19 protocols by the learners is inadequate. The learners will be getting the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID vaccine which is a two dose regimen with doses 21 to 28 days apart.

Benefits of vaccination:

- Reduce the chances of learners of suffering severe disease and death due to COVID-19.
- To return schools to normalcy when everyone in the school have been vaccinated ie, learners will attend school every day (no shift system), face to face teaching and learning returns and physical activities.
- Vaccinated learners will cut the transmission to general population including their families as they spread the disease without them being sick.
- Some in this age group comprises learners who are about to complete their high school education who would be pursuing tertiary education in and outside the country, the vaccination will be beneficial since in the near future vaccination will be a prerequisite for all international and regional travel and for entry into some tertiary institutions.


The Ministry of Health will be visiting all schools in the country to vaccinate all eligible learners in Primary and Secondary/High schools (public and private). The exercise will start on the 15th to 26th

November 2021, COVID19 vaccination is not compulsory in country but it is in the best interest of learners to vaccinate. The learners are kindly requested to bring their ID cards or ID numbers from their Birth Certificates during the vaccination and also to pre-register those who are able on the following website www.eswatinihealth.org. Registration will also be done on site (at School). Attached is the fact sheet on the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccinate.

NB: learners who are 18 years and above who missed the Johnson and Johnson will also be vaccinated.
